CALL FOR POSTERS!

The Houston Neuropsychological Society (HNS) would like to invite students, interns, and post-doctoral fellows to submit an abstract for presentation at the November 18, 2017 symposium. Deadline for RECEIPT of submissions is **Sunday, November 12, 2017**.

Posters must be available for viewing during the HNS symposium on Saturday, November 18, 2016 at the University of Houston. Set-up will begin at 8:00 am. Authors must be available to answer questions on their work during parts of the coffee break. During the symposium, the top-rated submission will be awarded a cash prize of \$100, and ALL trainees who submit a poster may attend the Symposium for **FREE**.

The Program Committee will review all abstracts, and their decision is final. We welcome new research, or work that may have been presented previously at a scientific conference within the past year.

PLEASE NOTE: Submission of poster implies registration and attendance at the conference, and presentation of the work. The program committee will review all abstracts, and their decision is final. We welcome new research, or work that may have been presented previously at a scientific conference, as long as the student is the first author.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION FORM

Identifying information: Complete all information of the author including first and last name, degree (BA, BS, MA, PhD, etc.), as well as the site at which the presented data was obtained.

Award Consideration: Please indicate if the author is a graduate student, intern, or post-doctoral fellow. The author of one outstanding submission will be awarded a cash prize of \$100. Of note, if you are a trainee, and you submit a poster, then your attendance at the Symposium is **FREE**.

Title and Text: Include a 250 word abstract in the box provided. Please **OMIT** authors from the text box, but include the complete title of the submission. Use 12 point font and single line spacing.

If you wish to submit a poster, please register online (use the coupon code “trainee”). Then submit the actual poster to Paul T. Cirino, Ph.D at (pcirino@uh.edu), using the subject line “**HNS Symposium Research Award**”.
