- Vote on April meeting minutes
 - Minutes approved
- Taxes and financial update from treasurer
 - Taxes were filed
 - Made \$1,400.97 for 2020
 - Minimal expenses for the year
 - Agu is in the process of transitioning information to Adam
 - HNS bank account listing of two board members
 - Need to add a second person to the bank account. Hannah will be added to be a backup for Adam. Paul will be removed from the account.
 - Yay: 10, Nay: 0
 - Discussed having the President-Elect as second person on the account since it is a three year commitment
 - It was proposed that next transition be the President Elect of Spring 2023
 - Zoom for HNS purchased
 - Secretary and Treasure will be primary members accessing the account, but the login (thehnsociety@gmail.com) and password are on the Google Drive
- CE talks for May through August
 - Corky's talk is upcoming and flyer has been sent out on listserv
 - Postdoc talk date 7/22, 7/26, or 7/29 @ 5:30 PM?
 - No apparent conflicts with student schedule for dates listed, per Chaniqua (Student Liaison)
 - Will try to recruit 2-4 postdoctoral fellows for talks
 - Stella will follow up with training directors of postdoctoral fellowships to recruit
 - Alyssa (Postdoc Liaison) will also assist with recruitment and correspondence with postdoctoral fellows
 - Tentative dates: 7/22 or 7/29 – will finalize date next month.
 - August – Adam, SBN panel, other topic suggestions
 - Adam agreed to do talk for August
 - Topic: Executive dysfunction and attention in depression
 - Kendra will touch base with SBN Board to determine availability for panel
 - Additional topic: Advocacy in Neuropsychology
 - Jenny: Advocacy, Networking, Mentoring, and Sponsorship in Neuropsychology may be nice topics to discuss during the Fall Social
- Talk invitations beyond HNS listserv
 - Corkey asked if HNS members could share virtual talks with other colleagues who are not HNS members
 - Hannah: Agrees with allowing non-HNS members to attend, but need to decide how to charge for the CE credit
 - Stella: Ideas would be to non-HNS members to attend but do not offer CE credits or charge a small non-member fee for CE credit requests

- Hannah: Could set up the website to take payments for non-member fees (example, fees for Fall Symposium)
 - Stella will touch base with Jenny to determine if this is feasible
 - Proposed \$15-20 dollars per 1-hour virtual CE
- Fall symposium speakers
 - In-person vs. online
 - Stella leaning toward keeping Fall Symposium virtual
 - May be safer, for planning purposes, to keep virtual. It is difficult to predict how flexible institutions will be in renting space, coordinating the event, etc.
 - Will keep Fall Symposium virtual
 - Potential speakers
 - Agu, Ciaran, Kendra – Huntington’s disease in adults
 - Stella will reach out to Ciaran formally to invite as a speaker and check availability in October
 - Juvenile HD? – Agu and Kendra will follow up with pediatric neurologist
 - Tentative Saturday date 10/16, 10/23, or 10/30?
 - Chaniqua and Alyssa will check calendar for students and postdocs for potential conflicts
